





INSTRUCTIONS


I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Remove the mirror from the packaging and identify all the parts before installation.
- 2. Select the desired location on the wall (use a stud finder to check for studs) to hang the mirror.
- 3. Use a measuring tape to determine the locations for the top and bottom wall mounting brackets.
- 4. Mark the locations for brackets and their anchor holes.
- 5. Lift the mirror to the marked points to ensure that the markings are level and align with the corresponding brackets on the mirror.
- 6. Drill the marked holes and insert the anchors into the holes.
- 7. Secure the wall mounting brackets to the wall with the provided screws.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) White wire and neutral power line wire
 - b) Black wire and hot power line wire
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting plate into the junction box.

III. Installing the Fixture



- 1. Lift mirror and rest it slightly above the wall mounting brackets and slide it down until the brackets on the mirror catches the brackets on the wall and interlock. It is best to have a second person assist with this installation.
- 2. Use the touch buttons to turn the mirror on/off, to change the brightness settings, and to defog condensation.
